Terms and Conditions for Certification Bodies' Use of Personal Information

- This Platform only provides certification bodies with members' personal
 information that can be used to search from the list of members qualified in tests,
 including members' family names, email addresses, locations, and the dates of
 the latest tests. The application is limited to searching for qualified members and
 their means of contact.
- 2. Certification bodies may not search for, collect, process, or use personal information other than the items stated in the previous article. Except for those allowed by the Personal Data Protection Act under specific purposes, certification bodies may not use that information for other purposes.
- 3. If a certification body wishes to collect, process, and use personal information outside the scope stated in Article 1, it will have to reach out to members and obtain their consent on its own. As the Platform has no involvement, certification bodies may not conduct those tasks in the name of the Platform. Certification bodies have obligations to maintain the confidentiality of members' personal information and must abide by the Personal Data Protection Act, Cyber Security Management Act, and other related rules and regulations.
- 4. Before collecting, processing, and using members' personal information, certification bodies must implement protection mechanisms that are more protective or at least equal to the Privacy Rights and Personal Information Protection offered by the Platform.
- 5. Certification bodies must implement adequate and effective information protection measures to prevent personal information from the danger of being lost, leaked, stolen, damaged, tampered with, or disclosed. If there is such a danger or risk present, certification bodies must take immediate actions to effectively contain those risks and prevent them from expanding. The Platform must be notified of such occurrences and how they are handled and what damages have they incurred.
- 6. This Platform may revise or change these terms at any time, and the revised terms will enter into effect upon announcement on the website. Certification bodies are responsible to be attentive to any revisions or changes. Certification bodies that do not agree to a revision or this term on revision must stop collecting, processing, and using members' personal information.
- 7. Complaints or disputes filed by members about a certification body's collection, processing, or use of personal information must be handled by that certification body, and the Platform is in no way involved. If the member makes a claim to the Platform on that basis, the certification body must compensate for the damage

- and benefit loss to the Platform (including but not limited to litigation expenses and lawyer fees).
- 8. The Platform may terminate a certification body's collection, processing, or use of members' personal, and that certification body must compensate for the damage and benefit loss to the Platform (including but not limited to litigation expenses and lawyer fees) under the following circumstances:
 - I. A certification body violates laws or the Terms and Policies of this Platform.
 - II. A certification body loses its accredited status.
- 9. Unless otherwise stipulated in laws, the certification body must return all the collected, processed, or used members' personal information once it has been terminated from collecting, processing, or using that personal information. It must also delete and destroy all originals, copies, or electronic files of members' personal information in its possession and present the proof of deletion and destruction.
- 10. The above terms and conditions are governed by the laws of the Republic of China (Taiwan). Both parties agree that any disputes or contentions that arise from those clauses must be exclusively brought in Taipei District Court, Taiwan for the first instance.
- 11. The English translation of the terms and conditions is for reference only. If its implication contradicts the Chinese version, the Chinese version takes precedence.
